Presentations are planned for the evenings of July 8, 9, and 10 (Tuesday-Thursday), and July 15, 16, and 17 (Tuesday-Thursday).

Each presentation runs from 7 to 9 p.m. at the Best Western Hood River Inn, 1108 East Marina Way, Hood River, OR 97031, Hwy 84 E, exit 63, left at light, cross over freeway, hotel on right.

Each presentation is self-contained and will be repeated each night, so you only need to sign up for one, but to make sure you get a spot, since seating is limited, request two or three nights that work for you.

The presentation will cover such topics as land ownership, land exchanges, the Goal 8 process, preliminary resort design, conservation easements, protection of the Crystal Springs water recharge area, ski permit area and planning, traffic, economic benefits and others.
