**Springs map stays**

Dave Riley stated in his June 18 "Another Voice" in the Hood river News that Mt. Hood Meadows no longer seeks to develop destination resort facilities on private land overlaying the state's accepted boundary for the Crystal Springs water district recharge area.

However, Mr. Riley also stated that Meadows disagreed with the boundary and had asked the Oregon Health Division to review it. I write to inform you that the Health Division has notified the District that it does not intend to make any changes to the boundary. The map presented by the District to the Planning Commission and the public constitutes the final certified delineation of the drinking water protection are for Crystal Springs.
